
Migrating off the HP e3000? - Migration Options for MiniSoft Customers

Dear MiniSoft customer,

Hewlett-Packard's decision to discontinue the HP e3000 computer family has many of our customers concerned about their options.

Here are a few suggestions of how to take advantage of MiniSoft products in this situation:

Migration Options for MS92 customers

1. Stay with MiniSoft 92 for Windows:
MS92 includes both HP and VT terminal emulation for running HP9000 host applications over Telnet, with the same familiar interface used to access HP e3000 systems.
2. Move to MS320, MS5250 or MS3270:
If you are on a current support contract for MS92, you can trade in your MS92 licenses for
 - MS320 for UNIX and OpenVMS or
 - MS5250 for the IBM AS/400 (iSeries) or
 - MS3270 for IBM mainframe connectivity,**at a generous discount.**

Migration Options for REFLECTION users

Migration Options for ODBC/32 and JDBC customers

1. ODBC/32 client modules are available for Linux, Solaris, HP-UX and Mac OSX in addition to MS-Windows.
2. ODBC/32 for Oracle is a new add-on module that makes MPE/iX data available to Oracle users, via Oracle's Heterogeneous Services/Generic Connectivity for ODBC.
3. Support for HP Eloquence under HP-UX, Linux and Windows Server is available, too, for both ODBC/32 and MiniSoft JDBC.
